

Longdean School – Behaviour Stages:

Stage	Sanction	Types of behaviour/Notes
1	<p>Class Teacher Detention up to 20minutes Tutor informed Parents could be informed Possibility of tutor report</p>	Class teacher to deal with low level disruption that does not effect others and set students a personal detention if strategies used to control students behaviour do not work e.g. remind student of appropriate behaviour, give student a choice or move students within the classroom. Types of behaviour include, wrong equipment, failure to complete work or homework, swearing in a lesson
2	<p>Middle Leader Detention - Run by Heads of Year and Heads of Department on a rota. Wednesday 3.20 – 4pm Parents informed Middle leaders informed Possibility of Pastoral Manager report</p>	Student behaviour that disrupts the learning of others e.g. Continually calling out, interrupting teacher, constant chatting in lessons, failure to attend a class teacher detention. On Call to be used to remove students.
3	<p>School Detention of 1 Hour after school – Thursday 3.30 – 4.30. Run by Senior Leadership Team Parents informed & possibly called in. Possibility of Head of Year report Possible support from outside of school</p>	Smoking, dropping litter, off site, 3 middle leaders detention in a half term, late to school or lessons 3 times in a week, failure to attend a middle leader detention
4	<p>Saturday Detention – 2 hours on a Saturday 9am – 11am. Run by Senior Leadership Team Parents informed & possibly called in. Head of Year report Possible support from outside of school</p>	Truancy, 3 school detentions in a half term, fighting, failure to attend a school detention.
5	<p>Isolation, run by behaviour manager. Possibility of different school day for students in isolation – 10am – 6pm. Parents informed Isolation report</p>	A student who is behaving poorly across the curriculum can be placed here by a Head of Year. They can also be placed here after a student has been removed from a lesson whilst an incident is being investigated.
6	<p>Exclusion – Head teacher to exclude based on recommendations from Heads of Year & Senior Leadership Team Parents called in Senior Leadership Team report Possible support. From outside of school.</p>	3 stage 4's in a term, physical assault of a student or staff, verbal assault of a teacher, inappropriate use of technology, dangerous behaviour, vandalism and damage to the school site.

In addition any student who repeatedly engages in behaviour that leads to Saturday detentions, time in isolation or fixed term exclusions will attend the Governors Referral meeting to discuss their behaviour with their parents and representatives from the Governing Body.
